

No-Till Equipment Rental Program

The District had a busy year moving our no-till equipment last year as equipment use was up compared to previous years. In total, 880 acres were planted with our no-till grain drills and corn planters. This equipment is available to Orange County farmers and while we do not require that they be used strictly as no-till planters, the District does encourage it.

We currently have two Great Plains No-till Drills and two John Deere Conservation Planters. The No-till drills include native grass seed boxes as well as a general grain box and a small seeds box. Our corn planters are 4 row planters with dry fertilizer boxes. Both planters now have row cleaners to clear trash out of the way of the planting units.
