

Orange County Dairy Farm Tire Disposal Project 2018



162,000 square feet (that's almost 4 acres!) of Secure Covers were delivered to Orange County on Monday (Sept. 17) as part of our project to help dairy farmers get rid of tires and replace them with an easier to manage method of holding down trench silo covers.

The delivery has already been sorted into individual orders that are ready for pick up by a dozen farms, just in time for filling corn trenches.

Thanks go out to Phil Johnson at Fort Hill Farm for providing space, machinery and time for distribution of the covers.

A second order has been placed for an additional five farms. We are currently exploring procurement of a machine to make the job of filling over 5,000 gravel bags easier and quicker. We are still working on identifying funding for tire disposal, with the goal of working on that daunting job over the winter months.
